FJLEPC MEETING CALLED TO ORDER:

Public Communications:

Business Outreach/Ways and Means:

Chairman Peterson reported that he is exploring ways for the FJLEPC to work with local chambers of commerce and will update everyone in the future.

HMERP Exercise Subcommittee:

Trice Burgess said that the county is on schedule for the planned drill at the Corbalis Treatment Plant in Herndon, Virginia, on October 19, 2018. Anyone interested in attending should email him in advance. Chairman Peterson asked if you attend to take pictures to share with the FJLEPC.

CCC Liaison Updates:

Liaison with other LEPCs:

Loudoun County LEPC reached out to Vice Chairman Ranck for assistance in getting their committee up and running. Trice provided them with the FJLEPC administrative procedures. Several of the local jurisdictions are interested in how using the teleconference dial-in function is working.

Shelter in Place Video:

Chairman Peterson reported he is still working with Patrick Balsamo, Fairfax County Channel 16, on translating the video via closed captioning. This is still pending. Chairman Peterson also inquired if there would be a cost to the FJLEPC which Mr. Balsamo indicated there would not.

HAZMAT RESPONSE TEAM (HMRT) UPDATE

RECENT INCIDENTS

Trice Burgess reported that HMRT assisted with major leaks on the Beltway and a major gas leak in the Fair Oaks section of Fairfax County.

HMRT TRAINING

The drill is October 19, 2018 at the Corbalis Treatment Plant in Herndon. Fairfax County and Fairfax City participated in a phone drill at the Tank Farm. There was a tabletop drill with EPA held on October 4, 2018 with representatives from local jurisdictions, state, and federal agencies.

FJLEPC COORDINATOR UPDATE

Tier II Manager Update & HMERP

Trice reported on the following:

- Total No. of Facilities – 588
- Total No. of Active Facilities – 432
- Total No. of Critical Hazard Facilities – 149

Currently, there is one property left to bring into compliance to have 100% compliance in Fairfax County. This facility has been reported to EPA Region 3 for assistance in bringing it into compliance.
